**Requirement Checklist and Notes (To ensure graduation, each box must be checked 'completed')**

- Residency Requirement: a minimum of 30 course credits and at least half (50 per cent) of the course credits required in each undergraduate degree program major/minor must be taken at York University.
- International exchange:** at least one full term abroad as a full-time student at one of York University's exchange partners
- Upper-level Requirement: at least 36 credits at the 3000-4000 level and can include credits within the major, language credits and internationally oriented courses. 18 credits must be at the 4000 level.
