<sup>3</sup> 6 credits at the 4000 level must deal with history outside Canada and USA; this presumes suitable preparation.

**Requirement Checklist and Notes (To ensure graduation, each box must be checked 'completed')**

- 6 credits at the 4000 level course that deals with history outside Canada and USA; this presumes suitable preparation
- Residency Requirement: a minimum of 30 course credits and at least half (50 per cent) of the course credits required in each undergraduate degree program major/minor must be taken at York University
- Upper-level Requirement: at least 36 credits at the 3000-4000 level. 18 credits must be at the 4000 level
